So Elijah went to Zarephath. As he arrived... he saw a widow gathering sticks, and he asked her, "Would you please bring me a little water in a cup?" ¹¹ As she was going to get it, he called to her, "Bring me a bite of bread, too." ¹² But she said, "I swear by the LORD your God that I don't have a single piece of bread in the house. And I have only a handful of flour left in the jar and a little cooking oil in the bottom of the jug. I was just gathering a few sticks to cook this last meal, and then my son and I will die." ¹³ But Elijah said to her, "Do not be afraid! Go ahead and do just what you've said, but make a little bread for me <u>first</u>. Then use what's left to prepare a meal for yourself and your son. 1 Kings 17: 10-13 (NLT)
