## CAN WE KNOW WHAT THE GREEK WORD "PISTIS" MEANS?

- Translation takes a word from the original to the desired language.
- Accurate translation requires an understanding of the original word.
- Understanding the original is found by examining common usage.
  - Common usage is determined by examining how it is used in the at the time and in other places in the .

Yet many leaders secretly believed in Him but would not declare their faith because the Pharisees continued their threats to expel all His followers from the synagogue; <sup>43</sup> here's why: they loved to please men more than they desired to glorify God. John 12;42-43 (VOICE)

Someone may say, "You have faith, I have actions." Show me your faith without any actions, and I will show you my faith by my actions. James 2:18 (ISV)
You see, his faith and his actions worked together. His actions made his faith complete. James 2:22 (NLT)
CLARIFYING WHAT PISTIS CAN BE AND WHAT IT SHOULD BE.
o My Pistis can be a belief that does not alter
Do you think that <u>believing</u> there's one God is going to get you anywhere? The demons <u>believe</u> that, too, and it terrifies them! <b>James 1:19</b> (VOICE)
away from the living God. <sup>14</sup> For if we are <u>faithful</u> to the end, trusting God just as firmly as when we first <u>believed</u> , we will share in all that belongs to Christ. <sup>15</sup> Remember what it says: "Today when you hear His voice, don't harden your hearts as Israel did when they rebelled." <sup>16</sup> And who was it who rebelled against God, even though they heard His voice? Wasn't it the people Moses led out of Egypt? <sup>17</sup> And who made God angry for forty years? Wasn't it the people who sinned, whose corpses lay in the wilderness? <sup>18</sup> And to whom was God speaking when He took an oath that they would never enter His rest? Wasn't it the people who disobeyed Him? <sup>19</sup> So we see that <u>because of their unbelief they were not able to enter His rest</u> . <b>Hebrews 3:12, 14-19</b> (NLT)
