1. I _____ TO GOD.

Moses said to the whole Israelite community, “This is what the LORD has commanded: ⁵From what you have, take an offering for the LORD. Everyone who is willing is to bring to the LORD an offering...”
Exodus 35:4-5a (NIV)

Then the whole Israelite community withdrew from Moses’ presence, ²¹and everyone who was willing and whose heart moved them came and brought an offering to the LORD for the work on the tent of meeting, for all its service, and for the sacred garments. **Exodus 35:20, 21** (NIV)

All who were willing, men and women alike, came and brought gold jewelry of all kinds: brooches, earrings, rings and ornaments. They all presented their gold as a wave offering to the LORD. **Exodus 35:22** (NIV)

2. I _____ TO GOD.

Bring to the LORD an offering of gold, silver and bronze; ⁶blue, purple and scarlet yarn and fine linen; goat hair; ⁷ram skins dyed red and another type of durable leather^[a]; acacia wood; ⁸olive oil for the light; spices for the anointing oil and for the fragrant incense; ⁹and onyx stones and other gems to be mounted on the ephod and breastpiece. **Exodus 35:5b-9** (NIV)

Then the Lord said to Abram, “You should know this: Your descendants will live in a country that is not their own. They will be strangers there. The people there will make them slaves and be cruel to them for 400 years. ¹⁴But then I will punish the nation that made them slaves. Then he erected the enclosure surrounding the tent and the altar, and set up the curtain-door at the entrance of the enclosure. So at last Moses finished the work. ³⁴Then the cloud covered the Tabernacle and the glory of the Lord filled it. ³⁵Moses was not able to enter because the cloud was standing there, and the glory of the Lord filled the Tabernacle. ³⁶Whenever the cloud lifted and moved, the people of Israel journeyed onward, following it. ³⁷But if the cloud stayed, they stayed until it moved. ³⁸The cloud rested upon the Tabernacle during the daytime, and at night there was fire in the cloud so that all the people of Israel could see it. **Exodus 34:33-38** (TLB)
