And now, a word to you elders of the church. I, too, am an elder; with my own eyes I saw Christ dying on the cross; and I, too, will share his glory and his honor when he returns. Fellow elders, this is my plea to you: 1 Peter 5:1

Let Christ himself be your example as to what your attitude should be.

Philippians 2:5 (Phillips)

And now, a word to you elders of the church. I, too, am an elder... 1 Peter 5:1a

So imitate me, watch my ways, follow my example, just as I, too, always seek to imitate Christ. 1 Corinthians 11:1 (VOICE)

Remember your leader who taught [proclaimed; spoke] God's message to you. Remember [Consider; Reflect on] how they lived and died [the outcome/result of their way of life], and -copy [imitate] their faith. Hebrews 13:7 (EXB)

Be shepherds over the flock God has entrusted to you.... Don't be rulers over the people entrusted to you... 1 Peter 5:2a, 3a (GW)

Listen to your leaders and submit to their authority over the community, for they are on constant watch to protect your souls and someday they must give account. Give them reason to be joyful and not to regret their duty, for that will be of no good to you. Hebrews 13:17 (VOICE)

And when the Great Shepherd appears, you will receive a crown of never-ending glory and honor. 1 Peter 5:4 (NLT)
