gathered together against the LORD and against his Messiah. <sup>27</sup> "In fact, this has happened here in this very city! For Herod Antipas, Pontius Pilate the governor, the Gentiles, and the people of Israel were all united against Jesus, your holy servant, whom you anointed. <sup>28</sup> But everything they did was determined beforehand according to your will. **Acts 4:25-28** (NLT)
