1. _____ **WHAT GOD HAS DONE FOR ME.**

- Jesus _____ for me.

My friends, I want you to remember the message that I preached and that you believed and trusted... ³ I told you the most important part of the message

exactly as it was told to me. That part is: Christ died for our sins, as the Scriptures say. 1 Corinthians 15:1, 3 (CEV)

- Jesus _____ for me.

He was buried, and three days later he was raised to life...

1 Corinthians 15: 4 (CEV)

I pray that you will begin to understand how incredibly great his power is to help those who believe him. It is that same mighty power ²⁰that raised Christ from the dead... Ephesians 2:19, 20 (LB)

2. _____ **THE SALVATION GOD HAS OFFERED ME.**

For it is by God's grace that you have been saved through faith. It is not the result of your own efforts, but God's gift. Ephesians 2:8 (TEV)

3. _____ **WITH PEOPLE WHO WILL HELP ME.**

Don't fool yourselves. Bad friends will destroy you.

1 Corinthians 15:33 (CEV)

You are not the same as those who do not believe. So do not join yourselves to them. Good and bad do not belong together. Light and darkness cannot share together. 2 Corinthians 6:14 (ICB)

4. _____ **GOD'S CALLING FOR MY LIFE.**

I am the least worthy of all the apostles... ¹⁰(yet) I have worked harder than all the others... 1 Corinthians 15:9, 10b (LB)

Here's a word you can take to heart and depend on: Jesus Christ came into the world to save sinners. I'm proof—Public Sinner Number One—of someone who could never have made it apart from sheer mercy. ¹⁶ And now he shows me off—evidence of his endless patience—to those who are right on the edge of trusting him forever. 1 Timothy 1;15, 16 (MP)

Therefore, if anyone is united with the Anointed One, that person is a new creation. The old life is gone—and see—a new life has begun! ¹⁸ All of this is a gift from our Creator God, who has pursued us and brought us into a restored and healthy relationship with Him through the Anointed.
