"Look at my hands. Look at my feet. You can see that it's really me. Now Thomas... one of the Twelve, was not with the disciples when Jesus came.²⁵ So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he said to them, "Unless I see the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe it." **John 20:24, 25 NIV**

While Pilate was judging the case, his wife sent him a message. It said, "Leave that innocent man alone. I've been very upset today because of a dream I had about him..."²² Pilate asked them, "Then what should I do with Jesus, who is called Christ?" "He should be crucified!" they all said.²³ Pilate asked, "Why? What has he done wrong?" But they began to shout loudly, "He should be crucified!"²⁴ Pilate saw that he was not getting anywhere. Instead, a riot was breaking out. So Pilate took some water and washed his hands in front of the crowd. He said, "I won't be guilty of killing this man. 4. BY _____ GOD _____.

Simon Peter and Thomas, who was also called Didymus, were there together. Nathanael from Cana in Galilee and the sons of Zebedee were with them. So were two other disciples.³ "I'm going out to fish," Simon Peter told them. They said, "We'll go with you." So they went out and got into the boat. That night they didn't catch anything.⁴ Early in the morning, Jesus stood on the shore. But the disciples did not realize that it was Jesus.⁵ He called out to them, "Friends, don't you have any fish?" "No," they answered.⁶ He said, "Throw your net on the right side of the boat. There you will find some fish." When they did, they could not pull the net into the boat. There were too many fish in it. **John 21:2-6 NIRV**
