If we say, "We have a relationship with God" and yet live in the dark, we're lying. We aren't being truthful. ⁷ But if we live in the light in the same way that God is in the light, we have a relationship with each other. **1 John 1:6, 7a NOG**

SECOND: THE TYPE I AM _____ OF WHEN COMMITTING IT.
