EXAMPLE #1: THE PEOPLE REFUSE TO FOLLOW MOSES INTO THE PROMISED LAND

THE _____ REQUEST: Go check out the land that God is going to give us.

The LORD said to Moses, ² "Send some men to explore the land of Canaan, which I am giving to the Israelites. From each ancestral tribe send one of its leaders." **Numbers 13:1, 2** NIV

THE ______RESPONSE: They're big, we're small, you ask too much.
