### 1. The Fellowship Springs from Devotion to \_\_\_\_\_.

Those who accepted his message were baptized... about three thousand were added... **Acts 2:41**

That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked at and our hands have touched... We proclaim to you what we have seen and heard, so that you also may have fellowship with us. And our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ. **1 John 1:1-3** NIV

This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers and sisters. <sup>17</sup> If anyone has material possessions and sees a brother or sister in need but has no pity on them, how can the love of God be in that person? <sup>18</sup> Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth. **1 John 3:16-18** NIV

### 3. The Fellowship Springs from Devotion to \_\_\_\_\_.
