The very spring of our actions is the love of Christ. We look at it like this: if one died for all men ... and his purpose in dying for them is that their lives should now be no longer lived for themselves but for him who died and rose again for them. 2 Corinthians 5:14 Phillips

Don't let selfishness...take over... <sup>4</sup> Get beyond yourselves and protecting your own interests; <sup>5</sup> In other words, adopt the mind-set of Jesus the Anointed. Live with His attitude in your hearts. Remember: <sup>6</sup> Though He was in the form of God, He chose not to cling to equality with God; <sup>7</sup> But He poured Himself out... **Philippians 2:3, 4-7a** VOICE

Giving grows out of the heart—otherwise, you've reluctantly grumbled "yes" because you felt you had to or because you couldn't say "no," but this isn't the way God wants it. For we know that "God loves a cheerful giver." 2 Corinthians 9:7 VOICE

And so it turned out that not a person among them was needy. Those who owned fields or houses sold them and brought the price of the sale to the apostles and made an offering of it. The apostles then distributed it according to each persons needs. **Acs 4:35** MP

Joseph, a Levite from Cyprus, whom the apostles called Barnabas (which means "son of encouragement"), <sup>37</sup> sold a field he owned and brought the money and put it at the apostles' feet. **Acts 4:36, 37** NIV
