When Jesus got to Bethany, he found that Lazarus had already been in the tomb four days. ¹⁸ Bethany was less than three kilometers from Jerusalem, and many people had come from the city to comfort Martha and Mary because their brother had died. ²⁰ When Martha heard that Jesus had arrived, she went out to meet him, but Mary stayed in the house. ²¹ Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died. ²² Yet even now I know that God will do anything you ask." [John 11:17-22 \(CEV\)](#)

The LORD says: "My thoughts and my ways are not like yours. ⁹ Just as the heavens are higher than the earth, my thoughts and my ways are higher than yours. [Isaiah 55:8-9 \(CEV\)](#)

Jesus told her, "Your brother will live again!" ²⁴ Martha answered, "I know he will be raised to life on the last day, when all the dead are raised." ²⁵ Jesus then said, "I am the one who raises the dead to life! Everyone who has faith in me will live, even if they die. ²⁶ And everyone who lives because of faith in me will never really die. [Do you believe this?](#)" ²⁷ "Yes, Lord!" she replied. "I believe you are the Christ, the Son of God. You are the one we hoped would come into the world." [John 11:23-27 \(CEV\)](#)

When Jesus had finished praying, he shouted, "Lazarus, come out!" ⁴⁴ The man who had been dead came out... [John 11:43-44a \(CEV\)](#)

He then told me to say: Dry bones, listen to what the Lord is saying to you, ⁵ "I, the Lord God, will put breath in you, and once again you will live. ⁶ I will wrap you with muscles and skin and breathe life into you. Then you will know that I am the Lord." ⁷ I did what the Lord said, but before I finished speaking, I heard a rattling noise. The bones were coming together! ⁸ I saw muscles and skin cover the bones, but they had no life in them.

⁹ The Lord said: Ezekiel, now say to the wind, "The Lord God commands you to blow from every direction and to breathe life into these dead bodies, so they can live again." ¹⁰ As soon as I said this, the wind blew among the bodies, and they came back to life! They all stood up, and there were enough to make a large army. [Ezekiel 37:4-10 \(CEV\)](#)
