Now the man had relations with his wife Eve, and she conceived and gave birth to Cain...” ² Again, she gave birth to his brother Abel. And Abel was a keeper of flocks, but. **Genesis 4:1,2** NIV

...what good is it to say you have faith, when you don't do anything to show you really do have faith? Can this kind of faith save you? **James 2:14** CEV

Don't you remember that our ancestor Abraham was shown to be right with God by his actions when he offered his son Isaac on the altar? ²² You see, his faith and his actions worked together. His actions made his faith complete. ²³ And so it happened just as the Scriptures say: “Abraham believed God, and God counted him as righteous because of his faith.” He was even called the friend of God. **James 2:21-22** NLT

Who were they who heard and rebelled? Were they not all those Moses led out of Egypt? ¹⁷ And with whom was he angry for forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose bodies perished in the wilderness? ¹⁸ And to whom did God swear that they would never enter his rest if not to those who disobeyed? ¹⁹ So we see that they were not able to enter, because of their unbelief. **Hebrews 3: 16-19** NIV
