



**Hebrews 11:30 · Joshua 6:1–20**

*By faith the walls of Jericho fell, after the army had marched around them for seven days. **Hebrews 11:30***

**1. MY FAITHFULNESS IS \_\_\_\_\_ FROM THOSE WHO HAVE \_\_\_\_\_ ME.**

*The LORD would speak to Moses face to face, as one speaks to a friend. Then Moses would return to the camp, but his young aide Joshua son of Nun did not leave the tent. **Exodus 33:11***

*Then Moses summoned Joshua and said to him in the presence of all Israel, “Be strong and courageous... The LORD himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged.” **Deuteronomy 31:7–8***

*And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others. **2 Timothy 2:2***

**2. FAITHFULNESS \_\_\_\_\_ WHEN I RECEIVE AN \_\_\_\_\_**

*Then the LORD said to Joshua, “See, I have delivered Jericho into your hands... March around the city once with all the armed men. Do this for six days.” **Joshua 6:2–3***

*Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight. **Proverbs 3:5–6***

*“For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways,” declares the LORD. **Isaiah 55:8–9***

**3. FAITHFULNESS IS FORGED IN THE SILENCE OF REPETITION**

*But Joshua had commanded the army, “Do not give a war cry, do not raise your voices, do not say a word until the day I tell you to shout.”*

**Joshua 6:10**

*Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. **Galatians 6:9***

*Because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. **James 1:3–4***

**4. FAITHFULNESS \_\_\_\_\_ MARCHING \_\_\_\_\_, NOT \_\_\_\_\_.**

*The armed guard marched ahead of the priests who blew the trumpets, and the rear guard followed the ark. **Joshua 6:9***

*And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together... but encouraging one another. **Hebrews 10:24–25***

*Two are better than one... If either of them falls down, one can help the other up. **Ecclesiastes 4:9–10***

**5. TO BE FAITHFUL REQUIRES ME \_\_\_\_\_ THE \_\_\_\_\_ OF GOD \_\_\_\_\_.**

*Take up the ark of the covenant of the LORD and have seven priests carry trumpets in front of it. **Joshua 6:6–7***

*God is within her, she will not fall. **Psalms 46:5***

*Seek first his kingdom and his righteousness. **Matthew 6:33***

**6. FAITHFULNESS BREAKS THROUGH WHEN I \_\_\_\_\_ THE \_\_\_\_\_.**

*When the trumpets sounded, the army shouted... and the wall collapsed. **Joshua 6:16, 20***

*Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. **Hebrews 11:1***

*Remember starting with Abraham we saw this...*

*Against all hope, Abraham in hope believed. **Romans 4:17–1***
