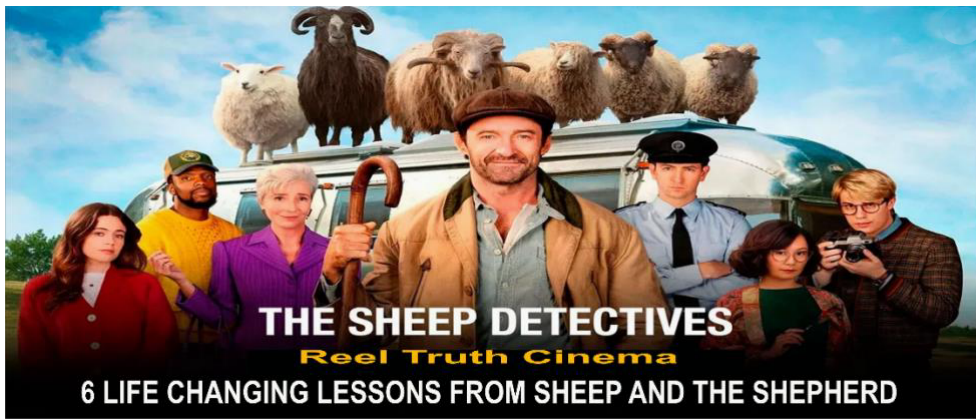




LESSON 1 - I NEED A _____ ... BECAUSE I AM A _____.
